

**ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR ADMISSION OF (10+2) VOCATIONAL CANDIDATES TO POLYTECHNICS  
IN WEST BENGAL IN THE 2<sup>ND</sup> YEAR OF 3 YEARS' DIPLOMA COURSES IN ENGINEERING &  
TECHNOLOGY UNDER LATERAL ENTRY SCHEME FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2009-10**

Applications are invited in prescribed form from the candidates who have passed (10+2) vocational examination under West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education & Training in the area of "Engineering & Technology" with flexibility in the subjects of study obtaining a minimum aggregate of 60% marks in the above examination for admission to 2<sup>nd</sup> year of 3 years' diploma courses in Engineering & Technology in Polytechnics in West Bengal under Lateral Entry Scheme for the academic session 2009-10. Candidates who will appear in (10+2) vocational examination in 2009, may also apply, but their candidature will be considered if they fulfil the requirement as stated above. Admission will be made through an Entrance Examination to be conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Technical Education, "Kolkata Karigori Bhavan", 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, 110 S.N.Banerjee Road, Kolkata-700013. The examination with multiple choice objective questions (MCQ type) consisting of two papers is scheduled to be held on Sunday, the 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2009.

Paper-I: Physics (25 marks), Chemistry (25 marks), and Mathematics (50 marks) = Total 100 marks, Time allowed = 2 hours.

Paper-II: Engineering Mechanics (50 marks) and Computer (50 marks) = Total 100 marks, Time allowed = 2 hours.

Standard of examination would be at the level of 10+2 vocational under West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education & Training either in the compulsory or optional subjects under revised syllabus effective from the session 2007. The candidates would be required to secure at least 20% marks in individual paper. Weightage on results of Madhyamik Pariksha would also be given in equal proportion, while preparing the merit list.

10% of the sanctioned seats in the polytechnics will be available for such admission.

**Eligibility:** Applicant(s) must be Indian citizen and should have passed (10+2) vocational education in Engineering & Technology under West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education & Training.

**Age:** Upper age limit is 25 years as on 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2009. For SC/ST/PC candidates relaxable by 3 years.

**Reservation:** Reservation of seats as per existing Government norms. SC/ST candidates of the State of West Bengal will only get the benefit of reservation. SC/ST/PC certificates issued after 3<sup>rd</sup> February, 2009 and by the competent authority other than that of Government of West Bengal will not be entertained for admission in the session 2009-10.

**Submission of Application:** Candidates willing to appear in the Entrance Examination should fill-in application in prescribed form which shall be made available together with the instruction booklet on and from 01.01.2009 to 21.01.2009 from the following polytechnics on all working days between 10.30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. and on Saturday between 10.30 a.m. and 1.00 p.m. (Sundays and holidays excluded) on cash payment of Rs.275/-. Application form once purchased cannot be taken back or exchanged.

Forms may also be purchased after the due date of 21.01.2009 on payment of Rs.375/- (Rs.275/- towards cost of form plus Rs.100/- as late fee) from the office of the Council at "Kolkata Karigori Bhavan", 110 S.N.Banerjee Road, Kolkata-700013 on all working days from 10.30 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. between 26.01.2009 and 30.01.2009 and may be submitted at the Council's Office at "Kolkata Karigori Bhavan", 110 S.N.Banerjee Road, Kolkata-700013 on all working days between 10.30 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. on or before 03.02.2009. Filled-in application forms sent by post will not be accepted. Incorrect, incomplete application may be cancelled.

The Council shall publish a merit list on the basis of the marks secured by the candidate in the Entrance Test plus the marks secured by him/her in the Madhyamik Pariksha (without additional paper) computed out of 200. Merit listed candidates will be required to appear before counselling board at specified place, date and time for admission to polytechnics. Admission of prospective candidates to polytechnics is subject to fulfilment of eligibility criteria by them. The result of this competitive examination based on multiple choice type of objective questions (MCQ) will not be intimated individually to the merit listed candidates. The result will be available in the website [www.webscte.org](http://www.webscte.org) and the printed results up to a specified rank will be available with Nodal Centres (i.e. Polytechnics) of the district. No request for post publication scrutiny, inspection and review shall be entertained. Mere submission of application for appearing in the Entrance Examination and/or securing a rank in the merit list does not entitle a prospective candidate for admission to any polytechnic.
